



Accessing CUSP events with Sched

1. Click the link from the CUSP site to visit the page for the event you are looking to join, e.g. Subject Leader Sessions: [CUSP Subject Leader Sessions 2024/25: About \(sched.com\)](https://www.sched.com/CUSP-Subject-Leader-Sessions-2024/25)
